	I have been shown how the inflatable is secured to the ground
	I have been shown how to turn on/off the blower(s).
	In the event of high winds or rain, I have been instructed to remove all participants from the inflatable and turn the unit off.
	I have been instructed to not allow any horseplay, wrestling, or unsafe activities in or around the inflatable unit(s).
	I have been instructed to not allow any sharp objects, eyeglasses, jewelry, food, drinks, shoes, silly string (or like products) in or around the inflatable unit(s). There is a cleaning fee for food, drinks, and silly string in the units of \$50 for bounce houses and combos and \$100 for slides and obstacle courses.
	I understand that adult (18 and above) operators must be present while inflatable units are being operated at all times.
	I understand that children of the same age or size group may use the inflatable units at any given time.
	I agree to remove any persons violating the rules of use from the inflatable units.
	I have received both written and verbal instructions on safe operation on the inflatable units and agree to follow all safety rules.
	For rides with slides, I understand that riders are to..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Slide down feet first and no more than two (2) sliders at a time • NO climbing on the slide the wrong way • NO jumping on the slide area
	In the event of Power Failure, Severe Weather Alert, or Medical Emergency please..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exit patrons in an orderly fashion • Turn blower off and unplug at power source • Keep patrons and guests away from inflatable unit Call appropriate emergency responders if necessary
	I have been given proper instructions at how the generator operates and understand it should be turned off when refueling.
